Hinkletown Youth Fellowship Work Week


August 3-9, 2020

In the midst of Covid, scheduling the youth Work Week trip has been as challenging as you might think. Our original plan was to go to Harlan, Kentucky with SWAP (Serving With Appalachian People) in June. As we got into late April, we began to get the impression that the trip was probably not going to happen. Sure enough, the beginning of May came around and SWAP cancelled all trips in June and July. Since August remained, we ended up switching our week to August 3-9 in Kimball, West Virginia. That was the plan until two weeks ago, when we were informed that SWAP cancelled all trips in August too.

All this to say that ending up in Juniata County is definitely a God thing, because it wasn't the first or second choice. Upon news of the second cancellation, we began exploring the option of staying at the Martin cabin in Juniata County and serving the local community in some way. We got connected to Christian Retreat Center (CRC) and had the opportunity to talk with their director, Zach Bashore. He said that during a normal summer they would have youth groups visiting from all over the state to stay at the camp and do projects in the local community. Covid cancelled most of those trips, so they had needs both at the camp and in the community. It was amazing how even at a late hour, God made a way where there was no way. We serve an awesome God!

So, what will we be doing? At CRC there are a number of cabins and other buildings that need pressure washing and repainting. There is also

flooring to be laid, retaining walls to be built, and a walking bridge to make. Zach assures us that we will not run out of work. In the community, there is a need for a 36' handicap ramp for a local woman named Edna. Additionally, we were connected with a thrift store
