In late September my class took a coach bus to Eureka, Montana! Our trip was about two weeks long. The first portion we spent at Riverstone Lodge and the second we spent at Big Sky Bible Camp. Throughout the trip our learning was focused on Native American history and what life is like on a reservation. It was a wonderful opportunity to learn from another culture and to develop an understanding and empathy for their stories. In our free time we explored the beauties of Montana by hiking, swimming, boating, rock climbing and many other adventures.
