spreading the Gospel. And this reality has caused many people to ask “Where do you even start?” It begins with prayer.

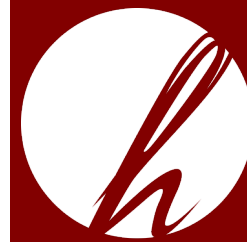
